

# Battery Handling Instruction



## Battery Bucket Instructions



You will find instruction, a plastic lining bag, and a prepaid return ticket (if you purchased directly from Upcycle) in the bucket.



Place the plastic lining bag in the bucket.



Fill up the bucket with waste batteries. Make sure not to overfill the bucket. 4/5 full is ideal.



Tie the plastic bag when the bucket becomes full.



Close the lid tightly all the way down.



Use the provided return ticket to book a collection. You can find the instruction on the left-hand corner of the ticket.

## Batteries you must tape terminals to recycle in our buckets

Lead Acid Gel Cell Battery (only accept less than 4kgs per battery)

If any Lithium batteries (i.e. cell phone battery, laptop battery, Li-ion, Li-Po) to be placed in the buckets by any chance, the terminal ends must be taped to reduce risks of short circuits, possible sparks or fire ignition. If such an event occurs as a result of not complying with the taping procedure, Upcycle or the shipping company do not hold any responsibility, nor liability for any damage.
